



Troubleshooting

No signal on the HDTV

- Check if the HDMI cable is securely connected.
- Check if you have selected the correct HDMI input on your HDTV.

Cannot connect to network

- Make sure the network / internet cable is securely connected and he Ethernet port property.
- Make sure the Wi-Fi network is connected and the security key for the encrypted network is correctly inserted.
- encrypted network is correctly inserted.

 Make sure you select the correct IP address settings.

Some HDTV cannot display the entire picture

- Setup the screen ratio on your HDTV as automatic.
- On your HDTV, go to the ratio type, choose automatically display the entire screen.

The remote control does not work

 Make sure the batteries are in a good condition and they are inserted correctly in the remate control.

• Make sure no objects block the path between the remote control and the signal sensor of your receiver.



Long press Back+OK button at the same time,

until it pop up the message of pairing successfully




